### SUBJECT: REVISIONS TO CHAPTER 12 - TRANSPORTATION

We have revised Chapter 12 of the *State Administrative & Accounting Manual* (SAAM), and added a new section on van management. The changes become effective on **May 1, 2007**. Please replace the entire Chapter 12 in your policy manual.

# **Key changes to Chapter 12 include:**

- Subsection 12.10.30 added special definitions for vans including 15-passenger full size, 12-passenger full size, cargo-full size, and mini-van.
- Subsection 12.20.25 was moved to Section 12.60.
- Subsection 12.30.20 modified language related to the use of seat belts, the prohibition of driving while under the influence, and the transportation of children.
- Section 12.50 added language regarding the phase-out of 15-passenger full size vans.
- Section 12.60 consolidated policies covering van management. Key elements in Section 12.60 include:
  - o Restrictions on van purchase, use and rental
  - o 15-Passenger full size van phase-out
  - o Van driver requirements
  - o Required safety education or training for drivers of full size vans
