#### **III. Budget**

- \$1.7 million in 11-13 Biennium
- If eliminated, \$635K allocated to DOC for adult database in 11-13
- Expenses associated with elimination: lease penalties (\$177K), unemployment (\$94K), annual leave payouts (\$43K), costs to move and maintain database (\$210-\$500K), etc.
- Prioritization of functions: Data & Research (database, reports, fiscal notes), Policy and policy implementation recommendations, SOPB
