Kim Gordon would like to add the DOSA and she offered to check with the WACDL/WDA lobbyist as to any background information. Clela added that she thought the DOSA bill may have died because of the amendment that added credit for time served which increased the fiscal impact. Keri-Anne offered to send the list to the members and share any information to the Commission.
