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Language in the Senate and House budget striking amendment requires the CFC in cooperation with appropriate agencies to develop recommendations for procedures and tools which will enable them to provide cost-effective racial and ethnic impact statements to leg bills affecting criminal justice, human services and education caseloads. The CFC must submit a report to the governor on or before December 31, 2016, outlining the recommendations.

#### **Statewide Reentry Council**

Pursuant to Second Substitute House Bill 2791 (WA statewide reentry council), one-time funding is provided for the Washington State Institute for Public Policy to conduct a meta-analysis on the effectiveness of programs aimed at assisting offenders with reentering the community after incarceration.
