During the 2010 Legislative session, a representative on the House PSEP Committee introduced a bill requiring registered sex offenders to pay a fee when they register each time. The bill did not pass out of that Committee. The bill may be reintroduced during the 2011 session. This Committee may want to consider recommending what position the Board should take on this issue.
