SUBJECT: SAAM Technical Correction – Section 25.60 Garnishments and Wage

Assignments

We have revised Chapter 25, Section 25.60, Garnishments and Wage Assignments, in the *State Administrative and Accounting Manual* (SAAM). The effective date for this change is March 21, 2011.

In Subsection 25.60.10.d, we revised the language to exclude any additional withholding taxes from the exempt earnings calculation. It has been determined that additional withholding is a voluntary deduction and does not constitute a deduction "required by law to be withheld" as contemplated in RCW 6.27.010(2).

We also revised the first and second answer worksheets in Subsection 25.60.50 to reflect this change. The Excel worksheets for calculating disposable earnings subject to garnishments and the instructions for filling out the worksheets are available on OFM's Payroll Resources website at: http://www.ofm.wa.gov/resources/payroll/garnish and overpymts.asp.
