SUBJECT: REVISIONS TO CHAPTER 10: TRAVEL

We have revised the Per Diem allowances referenced in Chapter 10: Travel of Washington's *State Administrative and Accounting Manual* (SAAM). These changes only affect Schedule B, High Cost Lodging and Subsistence Rates For The Continental USA. A replacement map is provided; however, Schedule B is maintained by the Federal General Services Administration on their web site at <a href="http://www.gsa.gov/travel.htm">http://www.gsa.gov/travel.htm</a> and is connected to SAAM 10.90.10 via an internet link.

This change in Per Diem allowances is effective October 1, 2000.
