SUBJECT: CHAPTER 12 - TRANSPORTATION; CHAPTER 50 - FEDERAL

COMPLIANCE; CHAPTER 75 - UNIFORM CHART OF ACCOUNTS; CHAPTER 80 - ACCOUNTING POLICIES; CHAPTER 85 - ACCOUNTING

PROCEDURES; INDEX; FORMS INDEX; AND GLOSSARY

We have revised several chapters of the *State Administrative and Accounting Manual* (SAAM). This change is effective July 1, 2006, and also includes updates to the Index, the Forms Index, and the Glossary.

Key changes to the policies include:

<u>CHAPTER 12: TRANSPORTATION</u> (http://www.ofm.wa.gov/policy/12.htm) (Sections 12.20, 12.30, 12.40, and 12.50)

- Clarifies language related to motor vehicles.
- Revises insurance provisions for contractors who drive state vehicles.

<u>CHAPTER 50: FEDERAL COMPLIANCE</u> (http://www.ofm.wa.gov/policy/50.htm) (Subsection 50.40.30)

• Increases the threshold for programs subject to CMIA regulations to \$35 million or more.

CHAPTER 75: UNIFORM CHART OF ACCOUNTS (http://www.ofm.wa.gov/policy/75.htm) (Sections 75.20, 75.30, 75.40, 75.70, and 75.80)

- Adds new agencies: 3570, 4120, and 5450.
- Deletes agencies: 0470 and 1220.
- Adds new rollup fund: HH Public Safety Employees' Retirement System Plan 2 Fund.
- Adds new accounts: 094, 10J, 10K, 10L, 10M, 10N, 10P, 10R, 10T, 10V, 10W, 11A, 11B, 11C, 11E, 11F, 11G, 11H, 11J, 11V, 488, 489, 490, 553, and 635.
- Deletes account 040.
- Adds budgetary and Full Time Equivalent (FTE) general ledger codes. These are existing codes that were not previously included in Chapter 75.
- Revises the description for sub-object code BD Health, Life and Disability Insurance to include the administrative fee for Flexible Spending Accounts.
- Adds new revenue source code 04DS Unclaimed Property Distributions.

<u>CHAPTER 80: ACCOUNTING POLICIES</u> (http://www.ofm.wa.gov/policy/80.htm) (Section 80.30)

- Clarifies policy for accrued pledges.
- Clarifies policy for recognizing vacation leave.
- Adds policy for termination benefits.
- Adds reference to statewide sub-subobjects.

<u>CHAPTER 85: ACCOUNTING PROCEDURES</u> (http://www.ofm.wa.gov/policy/85.htm) (Sections 85.10, 85.34, 85.50, 85.60, 85.65, 85.72, 85.85, 85.90, and 85.95)

- Includes expenditure authority in budgetary accounting requirements.
- Adds procedures for accounting for termination benefits.
- Expands the illustrative entry for special budgeted allocation transfers.
