Alternative solutions, such as using portable audio/video equipment or relying on personal devices, were evaluated but deemed insufficient. Upgrading the built-in technology is the most effective and sustainable solution to support the agency's communication needs.

2/28/	Dynamic Environmental Water Sampling Backpack: This is a portable eDNA sampling equipment that will allow WSDOT to assess streams for salmon presence in the field using simpler, less labor-intensive and more affordable methods than the spawner surveys employed to date. Adoption of this technology will allow WSDOT to discontinue reliance on and reimbursement to WDFW for on-the-ground salmon spawner surveys and shift to using eDNA tools to detect fish use upstream of completed fish passage projects. We estimate that purchase and adoption of this equipment will save WSDOT \$33,000 biennially.		10389 108	Purchase of this equipment will significantly reduce the labor and effort associated with verifying the presence of salmon in our streams. This work is necessary as part of our fish barrier removal program. Under the current approach, WSDOT spends about \$46K/biennium in labor and materials to perform spawner surveys. With this new technology, we expect this cost to be reduced to \$12,300, saving WSDOT about \$33K/biennium.

This transition required WSDOT to add NetApp storage to our AVS nodes to support the 300 TB file servers. Currently, the cost for NetApp storage is \$47,000 per month.  To reduce this expense, we have determined that the best course of action is to purchase additional hardware to be housed at the State Data Center and upgrade our existing hardware to be more resilient and sustainable. This new hardware will not only support the file servers with both storage and compute capabilities but will also facilitate the migration of our on-premises VMware infrastructure to Hyper-V. This transition is projected to yield significant cost savings by reducing licensing fees.  By upgrading our existing hardware we are able to better support the needs of special projects such as Mobile Lidar by posturing our
			559,089.77	hardware to expand its capabilities. The upgraded controllers will also provide resiliency with the hardware as the are replaced with a redundant pair that supports higher input output operations.
