- There will be a new general ledger (5180) for PFML will be an 035 reconciliation item.
 - Premiums will start with the January 10, 2019 payroll.
 - Employer costs will be charged to Subobject BK.
- The Affidavit of Lost/Destroyed Warrant form is in the process of being revised.
- <u>3SHB 1169</u> states that private student loan garnishments will be calculated differently than federal. Watch for a technical correction to the State Administrative and Accounting Manual.
