## **ORDINANCE NO. 541**

AN ORDINANCE of the Town Council of the Town of Mansfield providing for the annexation of certain territory to the Town of Mansfield, Washington, and incorporating the same within the corporate limits thereof, providing for the assumption of existing indebtedness, providing the same shall be subject to the Comprehensive Land Use Plan, and assigning zoning classification.

WHEREAS, a Notice of Intent to annex was filed with the Town of Mansfield, and
WHEREAS, a meeting was held with initiating parties resulting in a decision by the Town Council
to:

- 1. Accept the proposed annexation.
- 2. Require the simultaneous designation of public use district classification.
- Requires the assumption of a pro rata share of all existing Town indebtedness by the area to be annexed; and
- Prepare and approve a "pre-annexation" agreement that specified approval of the
  annexation would require preliminary approval of the planned development for the
  subject property and specific condition related to infrastructure.

WHEREAS, a Petition for Annexation was made in writing and filed with the Town Council and Planning Commission seeking annexation of real property described as follows, all of which property is contiguous to the corporate Town limits of the Town of Mansfield located at 491 RD 14 NE on the corner of State Route (S.R.) 172 and County Road (Ext. of Mansfield Blvd.)

WHEREAS, said petition was signed by the owners of the above-described real property; and

WHERAS, the Town Council fixed a date for a public hearing and caused notice thereof to be published and posted as required by law; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was duly held by the Town Council of the Town of Mansfield on the 9th day of April, 2025, and after said hearing a motion was made, seconded, and unanimously passed to approve the annexation of the subject property.

NOW, THERFORE, THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MANSFIELD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN as follows:

Section 1. Upon agreeing to meet all the conditions set forth, the real property described herein being situated within the County of Douglas, State of Washington, and being contiguous to the Town of Mansfield, shall be annexed to and incorporated into the Town of Mansfield.

Section 2. All property within the territory annexed shall. After the effective date hereof, be assessed and taxed at the same rate and on the same basis as the property within the Town

for any outstanding indebtedness of the Town of Mansfield contracted prior to, or existing at the date of annexation.

<u>Section 3.</u> All property within the territory so annexed shall be subject to and be part of the Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Mansfield as now adopted, or as hereinafter amended.

Section 4. The subject real property shall be zoned Public.

Section 5. A copy of this ordinance shall be filed and recorded as provided by law.

<u>Section 6.</u> This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage by the Council, approved by the mayor and five days after publication as required by law. This ordinance shall be published after the Douglas County Boundary Review Board process has run its course.

Mayor Wall informed council that the Annexation of the Mansfield School is underway, once Ordinance #541 is accepted and published and an Interlocal Agreement is signed by Douglas County Fire #5 the information will be presented to the Douglas County Boundary Review Board.

Mayor Wall informed the council that the children from the Mansfield School would like to paint the ecology blocks at the Douglas County Shop. Discussion followed. Council member Foged made a motion to reject the painting of ecology blocks, Lamar seconded, motion carried.

Mayor Wall informed the council that the children from Mansfield School will be meeting for Earth Day at Blue Stem Park to plant flowers.

Council member Tupling asked about the sale of property located on the east end of Railroad. Discussion followed.
