ISSUE STATEMENT(S):

Did the Employer violate article 17.2 of the parties' CBA when is assigned out of town overnight work to an employee with less seniority than Grievant as alleged in grievance 14-06?

AWARD:

The arbitrator, Michael E. Cavanaugh, ruled that the DOC did not violate the contract when it assigned out of town overnight work to an employee with less seniority than the Grievant. The arbitrator ruled that DOC does have the ability to look at job qualifications and/or case familiarity with the offender crew in determining who is assigned to work and therefore accrue overtime.
