Dear President Cauce:

Pursuant to enactment of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act (P.L. 116-136), I allocate \$23,964,000 from General Fund-Federal and \$1,866,000 from the Disaster Response Account to the University of Washington as outlined below.

**COVID Testing – \$18,482,000 (General Fund-Federal).** The purpose of this allocation is to pay for testing expenditures, including test development, triage and testing sites, and public health partnerships for contact tracing.

**Enhanced Cleaning for Safety – \$250,000 (General Fund-Federal) and \$748,000 (Disaster Response Account).** The purpose of this allocation is to pay for COVID-related cleaning services.

**UW Academy Health Professions – \$372,000 (General Fund-Federal) and \$1,118,000 (Disaster Response Account).** The purpose of this allocation is to pay for increased training for epidemiology students to support local virus response; increased PPE; capital upgrades to improve patient safety; required field learning for nursing, dental, and social work students; and virtual training costs for dental and medical students.

**UW Medicine Public Health Response – \$4,860,000 (General Fund-Federal).** The purpose of this allocation is to pay for capacity improvements, personal protective equipment innovations and protocols, workforce redeployment to support safety protocols, COVID-19 hotline support, rapid telehealth deployment, nursing home testing support, and regional COVID-19 coordination.

Please submit the required allotment amendment packets to OFM using the “Operating Allocation” packet type. For General Fund-Federal, use expenditure authority code 7Z0, and for Disaster Response Account-Federal, use expenditure authority code 8AO. If you have not already done so, please apply for expedited FEMA-Public Assistance reimbursement for the Disaster Response Account funds as soon as possible.
