Dear Director Brown:

Pursuant to enactment of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act (P.L. 116-136), I hereby allocate \$3,000,000 from General Fund-Federal (Coronavirus Relief Funds) to the Department of Commerce to create the Washington COVID-19 Food Production Paid Leave Program.

The federal government has mandated that employers in the food production sector offer up to 80 hours of paid sick leave to their employees to reduce the spread of COVID-19. However, it exempted employers with 500 or more employees. Therefore, Governor Inslee has created the Washington COVID-19 Food Production Paid Leave Program to offer temporary financial protection to our state's food production system by providing up to 80 hours of paid sick leave when an employee who works for an employer with 500 or more employees is quarantined and/or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19. This program is necessary to protect the community health in agricultural areas.

According to guidance issued by the federal government on the Coronavirus Relief Funds, for a cost to be considered to have been incurred, the performance or delivery must take place by December 30, 2020, but payment can occur up to 90 days afterwards. Please submit the required allotment amendment packet to the Office of Financial Management using the "Operating Allocation" packet type. For General Fund-Federal, use expenditure authority code 7Z0.
