On behalf of the Conservation Commission, our responses to your questions are below:

**Q1:** Services funded by appropriations in the enacted transportation budget (ESSB 5024).

**A:** None

**Q2:** Services that do not require an appropriation, e.g., from non-appropriated funds.

**Q3:** Services to continue based on certain constitutional mandates and federal law. (Please consult with your assigned assistant attorney general for clarification. The existence of a state statute or federal grant is not, by itself, a sufficient mandate for this purpose.)

**Q4:** Many important programs and services will cease absent timely legislative appropriations. Therefore, in addition to the categories above, I am also asking that agencies identify services that are necessary for the immediate response to issues of public safety, or to avoid catastrophic loss of state property.
