SUBJECT: SAAM Technical Correction 06-20

Due to the challenges caused by COVID-19, OFM is making changes to the fiscal year 2020 year-end due dates. We have revised Chapter 90, State Reporting and Chapter 95, Federal Assistance Reporting in the *State Administrative and Accounting Manual* (SAAM) effective **June 2020**.

Chapter 90: State Reporting

(Sections 90.20 and 90.40)

- Revised the fiscal year-end cut off dates for fiscal year 2020. (90.20.05)
- Revised the disclosure form due dates for fiscal year 2020. (90.40.10)

Timetable for Year-End Reporting and Closing:

NEW Due Date	Due Date	Reporting Item
June 30 - same	June 30, 2020	Last day of the fiscal year; cash cutoff (refer to OST's closing schedule memo)
July 13 - same	July 13, 2020	Disclosure Form application opens
July 31	July 17, 2020	Mail out interagency billings (whether based on actuals or estimates)
August 17	July 31, 2020	Phase 1 Close Agency accruals recorded. Prioritize interagency receivable/payable reconciliations as many agencies have an early internal close date.
August 31	August 17, 2020	 Phase 1B Close Certain state disclosure forms are due Interagency receivable/payable balancing is due Pollution remediation site status report is due

September 11	August 31, 2020	 Phase 2 Close Agency adjustments completed Remaining State and Federal Disclosure Forms are due (not including certifications) Disclosure Form application closes All agency adjusting entries made after Phase 2 require OFM approval.
September 18	September 11, 2020	State Financial Disclosure Certification form, including attachments, is due
Feb 26, 2021 - same	February 26, 2021	Federal Assistance Certification form is due

Agencies are encouraged to establish an internal close prior to September 11, in order to ensure that all entries are posted in AFRS and disclosure forms are completed by Phase 2 close. The Phase 2 close date is firm.
