SUBJECT: YEAR-END EXPENDITURES FOR COVID-19 RESPONSE WAIVER

In response to the Governor's order on March 11, 2022, "Washington Ready," the Office of Financial Management approves a waiver from the provision of the *State Administrative and Accounting Manual* (SAAM), Subsection 90.20.25.a, that requires the receipt of supplies and equipment by June 30 to be included as expenditures of the concluding fiscal year. This exception is granted to all state agencies and is for the fiscal period ending June 30, 2022.

Due to the current emergency and potential supply chain delays agencies may experience in receiving supplies and equipment, OFM will allow agencies to use fiscal year 2022 single year expenditure authority to pay for supplies and equipment received for up to six months after June 30, 2022. <u>This exception only applies for medical supplies needed for COVID-19 response</u>, vehicles, Correctional Industries furniture, and IT equipment. All purchases must have been ordered by April 15, 2022. Agencies are authorized to accrue purchase orders outstanding on June 30, 2022, and use those accruals to pay for supplies and equipment received by December 31, 2022. Agencies with federal funding may accrue the federal match but must ensure the correct federal grant period is charged when final payment is made. Accruals not used by December 31, 2022, should be liquidated using GL 3215, Revenue Source 04 86.
