

Superior Court Convictions 2013 – 2016

Chart 1 – Shows the aging out curve based on the Washington State conviction data. The peak of the convictions is at age 25 (4,435) and decreases from there on out. Convictions for those 15 years old at sentencing had a combined total of 4 for all four years and therefore were not included.

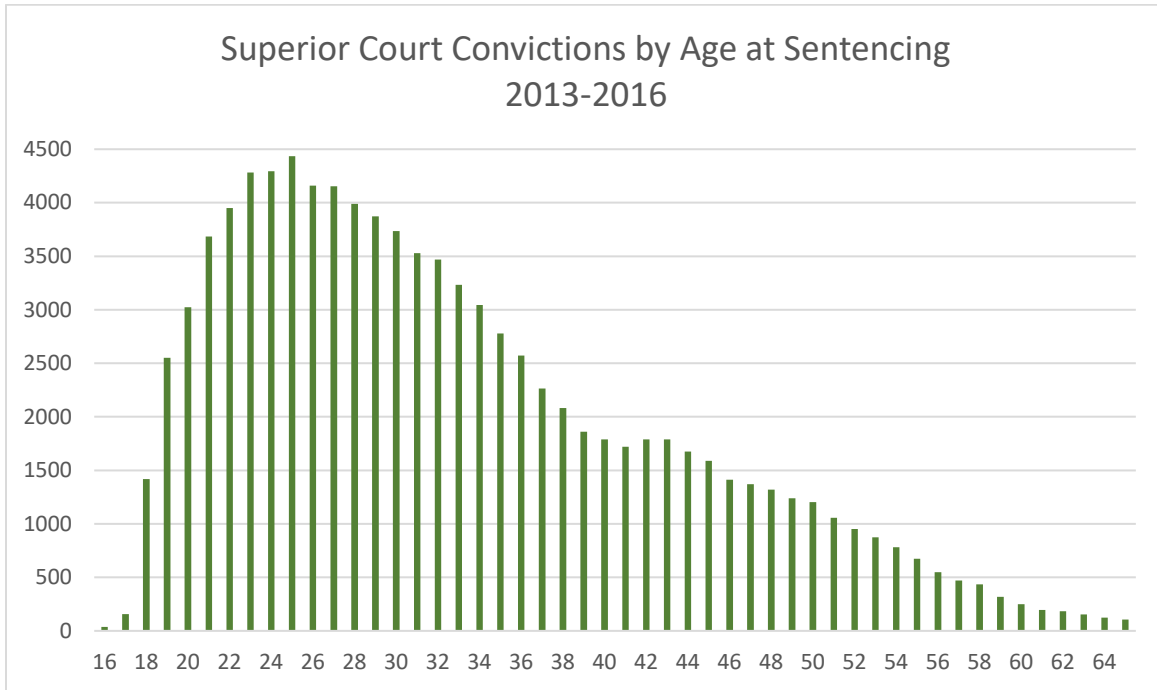


Chart 2 – In each fiscal year, convictions continually decreased after age 25.

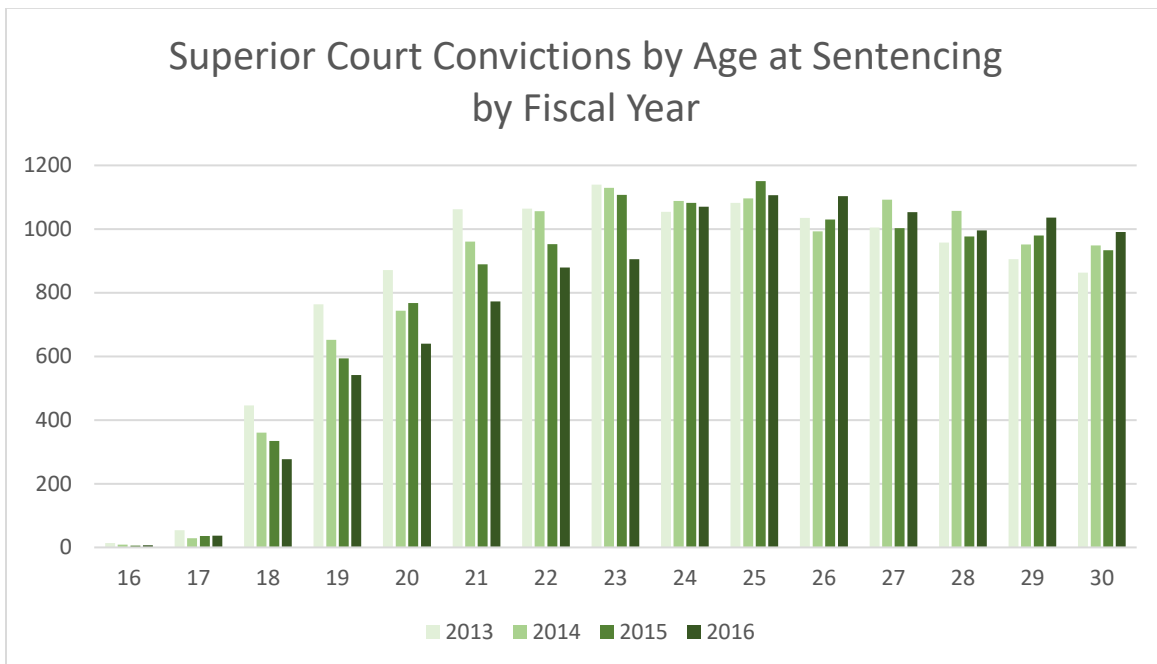
