How can agencies best prepare for an audit?

- Have grant awards and expenditure and revenue coding readily available for planning request
- Be prepared to provide key internal controls over federal compliance areas in writing
- Read the compliance supplement for your grants so you know what areas are applicable and will likely be audited.
