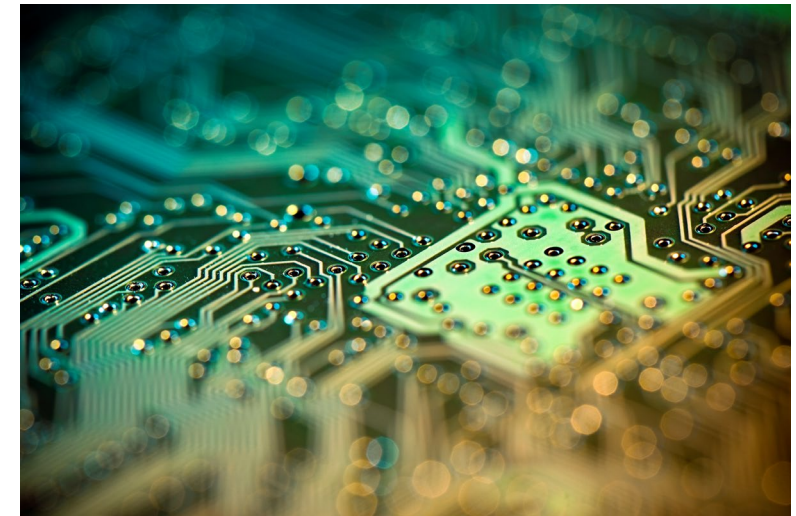
# Agency Survey Results

Agencies did not have interest in pursuing the subaward bulk upload API (Application Programming Interface).

- Not enough volume
- Cost to implement
- Lack of IT resources

# Agency Survey Results

## Issues reported for group discussion:

No way to print/save a useable copy of the report. Print to pdf is not good and there is no download option.

- Has anyone found a way to print to pdf in a useable way?
- Has anyone found a work around?





# Agency Survey Results

## Issues reported for group discussion:

No way to capture historical changes. System shows a last updated date but no option to document for audit purposes when original entry or amendments were reported.

- How are agencies handling this?
- Have any agencies had any feedback from auditors?



# Agency Survey Results

## Issues reported for group discussion:

When an Agency submission procedure requires a second person to review and approve entries prior to submission there is no way to document the review without a pdf or other copy of the report?

- Are other agencies having this problem?
- Has any agency found a good workflow?
