**Purpose:** Amend WAC 357-31-255 to allow an employer to grant up to three days leave with pay to an employee who is experiencing extraordinary or severe impacts from the 2023 wildfires referenced in Governor Jay Inslee's Emergency Proclamation, #22-05 effective August 19, 2023.

#### EMERGENCY RULE

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

- That immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.
- That state or federal law or federal rule or a federal deadline for state receipt of federal funds requires immediate adoption of a rule.

**Reasons for this finding:** Effective August 19, 2023, Governor Jay Inslee issued an emergency proclamation, #23-05, 2023 Wildfires, which directed state agencies and departments to utilize state resources to respond to the event. State employees have been directly and severely impacted by this emergency, including loss of their homes and residences. In these extreme and urgent circumstances, the temporary relief provided by this emergency rulemaking is necessary to sustain the health, safety, and welfare of our state workforce.
