Abolished Final Effective February 10, 2006

Definition: Performs work of graduated complexity in a training capacity in order to achieve journey level status in the L&I Auditor 3 classification. The L&I Auditor 3 is an apprenticeable job that has been approved by the Washington Apprenticeship and Training Council.

Distinguishing Characteristics: Positions in this class are distinguished by assignment as an apprentice trainee for the journey class receiving on-the-job and academic training to achieve journey status.

Minimum Qualifications: Must be at least 18 years of age. **AND**

High school diploma or GED.
