FIRE CHIEF – DOC (41940)

Abolished Effective July 1, 2007

Definition: Within the Department of Corrections, directs the emergency response program for fire, medical aid, and hazardous materials emergencies on McNeil Island, 24-hours a day, seven days a week, protecting life and safety of McNeil Island staff, inmates and island residents. Monitors a fire suppression-training program that meets or exceeds state and local requirements.

Minimum qualifications:

Four years of experience as a lieutenant or above at a fire department involved in fire suppression activities.

OR

Two years of experience as a lieutenant or above at a fire department involved in fire suppression activities which includes at least one year as a fire codes enforcement officer.

College-level course work in fire protection engineering or an allied field will substitute, year for year, up to two years of experience.
