ASSISTANT HERDS MANAGER

Abolished Effective February 10, 2006

DEFINITION

Assist with the care and management of livestock.

DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS

Positions within this class assist higher level personnel with the maintenance of livestock herds and general animal care; and are expected to adequately service a livestock herd in the absence of direct supervision.

TYPICAL WORK

Perform duties involved in the feeding, housing, and breeding of livestock and related procedures for research projects;

Inspect health and condition of animals daily and assist with the grooming and fitting of livestock;

Assist with laboratory demonstrations;

May maintain feeding, breeding, and herd records;

May assist in milking operations;

Perform related duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

High school graduation or equivalent and two years of work experience maintaining livestock.

College training in animal science or an allied discipline may be substituted year-for-year for required experience. One year of additional applicable experience may be substituted for educational requirements.

Specified course work or experience within a discipline may be required.

Examination Requirements:

A job element examination (including written, E & T and oral components) scored on the basis of job related experience, training, skill, ability and other elements which are established through job analysis.
