DEFINITION

Lead the work of creamery operators and assistants in dairy product processing.

DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS

Positions in this class are distinguished by responsibility for assigning and leading the work of creamery operators and student assistants in creamery operations.

TYPICAL WORK

Schedule, assign, train and lead creamery operators and assistants in the processing of milk and dairy products;

Inspect all equipment and facilities for sanitary conditions;

Perform routine laboratory tests on products;

Responsible for farm pickup of milk, delivery of finished products, and warehousing;

Maintain production schedule and product inventory;

Maintain production records and prepare reports;

Perform related duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

High School graduation or GED Certificate; possession of a valid, approved driver's license and three years of full-time experience in creamery or dairy processing work.

Ability to obtain a food handler's permit and appropriate state licenses.

Additional work experience may substitute year-for-year for required education.

Equivalent education/experience will substitute for all minimum qualifications except when there are legal requirements, such as a license/certification/registration.
