FARM EQUIPMENT OPERATOR II

Abolished Effective February 10, 2006

DEFINITION

Operate and maintain a variety of light, medium, and heavy farm equipment in agricultural operations; lead equipment operators and helpers.

DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS

Positions within this class serve in a lead capacity for crews of farm equipment operators and laborers.

TYPICAL WORK

Lead the operation of farm equipment in general farming operations;

Operate a variety of earth-moving or excavation equipment to level or excavate earth for construction of buildings, fences, drainage ditches, irrigation lines, and preparation of experimental fields;

Direct farming operations in absence of supervisor;

Adjust equipment in the field and perform emergency field repairs;

Haul farm equipment, gravel, ensilage, feed, hay, manure, straw, and other materials;

Grade roads, clear ground, pack silage, and move buildings;

Perform related duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

One and one-half years' of full-time experience including the operation and maintenance of power-driven farm implements.

Equivalent education/experience will substitute for all minimum qualifications except when there are legal requirements, such as a license/certification/registration.

Examination Requirements:

A job element examination (including written, E & T and oral components) scored on the basis of job related experience, training, skill, ability and other elements which are established through job analysis.
