Use the Non Employee action reason to identify actions on those individuals excluded from statewide employee headcounts and enterprise reporting. Non Employee action reasons are available for all Action Types.

Interns:

• If the wages for paid interns are not reimbursed by their school, code them as non-permanent employees rather than non-employees. Use the Internship action reason for New Hire, Rehire, and Concurrent Employment actions.

• If interns are part of a work study program and all or part of their wages are reimbursed by their school, code them as Non Employee Work Study Students and use the "Non Employee" action reason for all actions.
