## What is WA Grant?

- Need-Based Entitlement Student Financial Assistance Program for eligible Washingtonians.
- Expands access to financial aid beyond Federal Student Aid programs (restricted to citizens and eligible noncitizens) and Registered Apprenticeship programs.



Making free college or career training possible

# **Eligibility Requirements**

- Washington State Resident for at least 1-year
- High School Diploma or Equivalent or Ability to Benefit (ATB)
- Cannot have a bachelor's degree or higher
- Cannot owe money for state grant/loan
- Meet income requirements
- Be in an approved state-Registered Apprenticeship Program

## Native American Apprentice Assistance Program (NAAAP)

NAAAP is providing block grants (up to \$150,000) to Federally recognized Tribes, who will then award <u>up to \$10,000 each</u> to qualifying apprentices.

- Open to all 29 Federally recognized Tribes in WA
- Apprentices must be members of a participating Tribe and enrolled in a WA Registered Apprenticeship
