Dear President Cauce:

On November 18, 2020, I allocated \$21,875,000 (UAR #0166) of General Fund-Federal (Coronavirus Relief Funds) to the University of Washington to replace amounts previously allocated from the Disaster Response Account. This amount was to be used as the state's contribution under FEMA's Public Assistance program.

Due to the Presidential memorandum of February 2, 2021 directing FEMA to reimburse 100 percent of eligible expenses, the state's contribution is no longer required. Therefore, I have reduced the Coronavirus Relief Funds allocation to the University of Washington by \$21,875,000.

Using expenditure authority code 7Z0 for General Fund-Federal (Coronavirus Relief Funds), please submit the required allotment amendment packet to OFM using the "Operating Allocation" packet type.
